What is Stillpoint?

STILLPOINT is a house of prayer and Christian ministry within the Contemplative Tradition, which encourages and supports people to grow and deepen their union and openness to God, through monastic and other contemplative practices.

Stillpoint invites and encourages groups and individuals to take time out to pray, refresh, renew and discover more of the "life in all its fullness" that Jesus offers, through personal or group retreats, practical learning, spiritual direction and the offer of contemplative worship.

Stillpoint also takes its ministry to churches and the wider community to provide teaching and resources in contemplative practices to encourage and support people in their spiritual journey.

Stillpoint is home to the Stillpoint Faith Community, which offers a contemplative worship experience, and the Companions of St. Benedict, a group exploring monastic spirituality and how its wisdom can be a guide for contemporary disciples of Jesus.



What Stillpoint can do for you and your church

Personal and Small Group retreats

Stillpoint has two quiet rooms where you can reflect and pray privately. These are suitable for individuals, ministry teams, small groups (with a maximum of 15 people). Materials, spiritual direction and facilitation are available on request. Cost starts from \$30.
